Building Regulations

The latest updates to ensure the *"health, safety, and welfare of people in or about buildings".*

Part J: Check Chimney flues are clean before using them for first time during Christmas; and Check Carbon Monoxide alarms. Part B, Check Fire/Smoke alarms. Do NOT plug in rechargeable items or Escooters in access or fire escape routes. Always use chargers and cables that are rated for your appliance; never leave phones, tablets laptop etc. charging in bedcovers.

Part F Check vents in all rooms working, don't block- need fresh air & get rid of stale air.

<u>Part K</u>: When using <u>ladders during</u> <u>Christmas take adequate provisions to</u> <u>check and secure them.</u>

Looking out windows for Santa: check window Safety restrictors (100 mm max opening) and guarding to prevent falls. For children under 5 all guarding must be such that a 100 mm diameter sphere cannot pass through any opening i.e., child's head and check guarding is not readily climbable. Part M: Check handrail location and design appropriate for safety and mobility of occupants; older population, accompanied by an increase in age-related disability. Part D: Don't forget for Construction during Winter months to read the Guidelines for Concreting in Cold Weather Remember to ensure Construction Safety in **Freezing Weather Conditions**

2023 Market Surveillance activities included inspections & formal checks for compliance with the Construction Products Regulations guided by the Market Surveillance of Construction Products Strategy 2023 -Ireland. This office received 49 complaints; carried out 30 reactive, 42 proactive and 42 desk-top inspections; had 110 tests performed in laboratories; performed 42 checks of products and/or documentation e.g., CE Mark, DoP, Safety Information in Use; issued 48 requests for information; assisted another Member State Market Surveillance Authority; attended two AdCo meetings in Europe; two Market Surveillance Working Group meetings; delivered a "CPR Webinar - Aggregates", CPD Day on Market Surveillance of Construction Products attendance of 550; European Parliament Petitions Committee meeting and progressed recommendations in the "Report of the Market Surveillance of Construction Products produced from County Donegal Ouarries 2021/2022" 2024 will build on the progress to date.
